The clinic does not accept insurance payments but sets fees that will not be a burden to the client. Fees for assessment services are also based on a sliding scale.

Services address children's physical, mental, emotional and educational needs while providing families with the help they need to prevent removal of children from the home and move toward healthy long-term safety and stability.

The In-Home Service Specialist, together with the referral source, will work with each family to help meet their specific goals using the Family Wellness Curriculum. Intensive short-term home-based interventions are aimed at assisting families in learning to live together in an environment that is safe and nurturing. Referrals may be made by any community partner, DCBS or self-referral.

These stops include stores, apartment communities, city and county offices and businesses. The Berea route is on an hour-long loop and riders will be able to get off at any stop. The Richmond route is on two 90-minute loops and riders will be able to get off at any stop. Wheelchair assisted doorto-door service is available for no additional cost. - ✤ A single person with a disabling condition who is living on the streets (place not meant for human habitation) or in a shelter.
 - HUD defines "disabling condition" as "diagnosable substance use disorder, serious mental illness, developmental disability, or chronic physical illness or disability, including the co-occurrence of two or more of these conditions. A disabling condition limits an individual's ability to work or perform one or more activities of daily living."
- This person must have been continuously homeless for a year or more or has had at least four episodes of homelessness in the past three years.
