Social Worker II

The Madison County Health Department is accepting applications for Social Workers/Case Managers for the Home and Community Based Waiver (HCBW) Program.

General Duties include: This position serves under general direction of the Home and Community Based Waiver Manager. Responsibilities for this position include but are not limited to: provide HCBW case management services to participants in their homes or in adult day care. Will be required to document work timely in the electronic medical record and MWMA computer programs. Will be required to complete plan of care meetings and monthly case management visits and assist patients with referrals for needed resources.

<u>Social Worker II: Minimum Education, Training or Experience</u>: Bachelor's Degree with a major in Social Work, Psychology or Sociology and one (1) year experience in professional social work that includes patient assessment and case management.

Starting Salary Range: \$20.30 - \$25.24 per hour. Grade 17.

Salary is contingent on relevant work history and education and must be included to be considered in the starting rate of pay.

Special Case Management Requirements in the Home and Community Based Waiver Program are as follows: a bachelor's degree in a health or human services field from an accredited college or university; and at least one (1) year of experience in a health or human services field; or the educational or experiential equivalent in the field of aging or disabilities; or a Registered nurse who has at least two (2) years of experience as a professional nurse in the field of aging or disabilities.
