The Madison County Health Department is accepting applications for a **Senior Social Worker** for the Home and Community Based Waiver (HCBW) Program.

Benefits include State Retirement, Health, Life, and Dental insurance, paid vacation and sick days, paid holidays, Deferred Compensation, and work-related travel reimbursement.

Responsibilities for this position include but are not limited to: provide HCBW case management services to participants in their homes or in adult day care. Will be required to document work timely in the electronic medical record and MWMA computer programs. Will be required to complete plan of care meetings and monthly case management visits and assist participants with referrals for needed resources.

Sr. Social Worker: Minimum Education, Training or Experience: Bachelor's Degree with a major in Social Work, Psychology or Sociology and one (1) year experience in professional social work that includes patient assessment and case management.
